The Selective admission criteria will use the ACT composite score or COMPASS scores that favors the student.</p> <p>* All pre-requisites must be completed prior to admission to the Surgical Technology Program</p> <p>*The selective admission deadline is June 1st of each year and the program will start in the fall each year.</p> <p>* The program includes a Fall , Spring and a four week Summer semester.</p> <p>*The program is a full-time 5 days a week program. For the first 10 weeks of the program, the program focus is on the classroom/lab skill. During the last 5 weeks of the Fall semester we begin Clinicals and the schedule changes. M, F Lecture , and TWR Clinical, that schedule continues in the Spring semester.
