Notes & Additional Information*	<p>* Surgical Technology Diploma required minimum scores: ACT composite score of 16, or COMPASS – Reading- 76, English- 57, Algebra- 35 (or Pre-algebra- 34).</p> <p>* Pre-requisites required minimums on the ACT or COMPASS vary.</p> <p>* Selective Admission Program: Based on the Selective admission criteria I would recommend that all students complete the COMPASS Exam. The Selective admission criteria will use the ACT composite score or COMPASS scores that favors the student.</p> <p>* All pre-requisites must be completed prior to admission to the Surgical Technology Program</p> <p>*The selective admission deadline is June 1st of each year and the program will start in the fall each year.</p> <p>* Computer Literacy can be completed via Bypass Exam</p> <p>* The above sequencing for the First year is not required in that order; however the second year is required as stated.</p> <p>* The above sequencing is based on full time enrollment.</p> <p>* If developmental courses are needed the above sequence will need to be modified based on student needs.</p> <p>* BIO 130 Aspects of Human Biology is acceptable by KCTCS curriculum, however BTC Faculty recommends BIO 135 Basic Anatomy & Physiology</p> <p>* The AAS degree can be completed after obtaining the Diploma. By complete the classes required for the AAS.</p> <p>* The program includes a Fall , Spring and a four week Summer semester.</p> <p>*The program is a full-time 5 days a week program. For the first 10 weeks of the program, the program focus is on the classroom/lab skill. During the last 5 weeks of the Fall semester we begin clinicals and the schedule changes. M, F Lecture , and TWR Clinical, that schedule continues in the Spring semester. The summer semester is 5 days week clinicals and 1 week of Certification Review.</p>
