Brief Job Description: The Student Sustainability Steward will assist the BCTC Sustainability Committee with education and outreach about various sustainability issues (cartridge, paper, aluminum, and plastic recycling; water conservation; energy conservation; litter control; and other issues). The Steward will help collect and sort recyclables, and will assist with development and dissemination of sustainability education programs. Other sustainability-related duties as assigned.
