Brief Job Description: Serve as caretaker of BCTC's 2.25 acre community garden. This garden, Peace Meal Gardens, is located adjacent to the Leestown Campus and includes a greenhouse, an orchard, perennial plant areas, a sunflower garden, an herb garden, berry patches, and community plots. Caretaking includes weeding, mowing, bedding plots down for the winter and preparing for spring planting, and tending cool (fall/spring) crops.

Preferred qualifications: No synthetic pesticides or fertilizers are allowed on this garden. Tilling is prohibited, except in unusual circumstances. The intent is for this garden to be actually ecologically sustainable over the long-term. Thus, the garden caretaker must have an interest in and commitment to ecological principles. Preferably, the caretaker should either have experience on an organic farm (or urban garden), be a student in BCTC's EST program, or be planning to pursue a bachelor's degree in Sustainable Agriculture.
