Results: Program Coordinator:

1. Strengths of the Program - Our online portion of the program is still growing. We have sections of classes fill before the priority registration has been started or completed. We have the certificates, diplomas and degrees that the students are very interested in. 2. Items Requiring Continued Attention - We still need to be made known. This program has been very active; however, since we moved to Regency Campus, the in person classes do not make or have very low enrollment. 3. Document and provide evidence indicating how last year's program review resulted in improvements in the program/department. The classes for the student's success has improved. We are starting to track the student's taking the Coding exam and the success rate for that. We have added classes to the Lawrenceburg campus. The campus director has requested to have the MIT program on the Winchester Campus for the Fall 2012.

AD Comments: The MIT program continues to provide one of the largest online programs in our college. The results of the objective related to improving grades in OST 103 are impressive as this is a beginning course for the majority of the credentials offered in the program. We need to continue to create opportunities to promote the MIT program. MIT is a strong program and the demand is certainly significant for well qualified candidates. Focusing on additional in-person classes is based on the demand from the students; however, the in-person class enrollments are often low and the classes are often cancelled much to the dismay of many students. We have highly effective faculty in the program and continue to add adjunct faculty where needed. While MIT is a very sound program, the program coordinator should continue to work with the MIT faculty to further program growth.

Dean Comments: Agree with the AD comments. Continue with the online classes and assess if in-person classes will fill at the other campuses. Grow advisory committee and thus involve the community.

VP Comments: This is a model program in so many ways, including the eagerness of faculty to meet workforce needs. I wish all program facultywerethis committed to keeping their curricula relevant in terms of content and in terms of delivery.
