

## **Checklist for Newly Admitted Students**

Apply for Financial Aid - Students seeking financial aid must complete the FAFSA form online at <a href="https://www.FAFSA.ed.gov">www.FAFSA.ed.gov</a> (BCTC Title IV code: 005244). If you have questions, call the BCTC Financial Aid Office at 855-246-2477 or go online to <a href="https://energia.com/help.bluegrass.kctcs.edu">help.bluegrass.kctcs.edu</a> .
Schedule COMPASS Testing if Required for Class Placement - Allow at least one hour test time for each subject (English, math, reading) for which you need to test.
Schedule Your Appointment for Mandatory Advising - If you need to take any placement tests this appointment must be for a time after the tests are finished. If you have not already made appointments, go to <a href="www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/sa/advising/appointments">www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/sa/advising/appointments</a> . If you have questions, please feel free to contact the Advising & Assessment Center at 859-246-6220 or toll free at 866-774-4872, ext. 56220.
Activate or Reset Your User ID and Password.
<ul> <li>Using Microsoft Internet Explorer, open the BCTC home page www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu.</li> <li>Click User Account Center in the dark blue band at the top of the webpage.</li> <li>Click on KCTCS User Account Center in red – enter your birth month &amp; day.</li> <li>Identify yourself by filling in only the boxes provided for your KCTCS ID#</li></ul>
*Important: If your username is not listed, DO NOT CONTINUE, contact Tech Support at 859-246-4600 or go to <a href="http://bluegrass.kctcs.edu/en/its/technical_support.aspx">http://bluegrass.kctcs.edu/en/its/technical_support.aspx</a> & submit an assistance request.
To Log in to PeopleSoft – go to BCTC home page <u>www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu</u> ►Click on Student Self-Service at the top of the page ►enter your username & password ►click Sign In.
<b>To log in to E-mail</b> (You can't access e-mail until 24 hours after you are registered in classes in PeopleSoft) ▶Open the BCTC Home Page <u>www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu</u> and ▶Click on <b>E-mail</b> (top right).
To log in to Blackboard (For taking online classes - will work closer to the start date of the semester) ►Open BCTC Home Page <u>www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu</u> ►click Blackboard (top right) ►Enter username & password
Register for Your Classes in PeopleSoft Student Self-Service - Use the instructions provided by your advisor. If you haven't been provided instructions please go to <a href="https://www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/Advising_and_Assessment">www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/Advising_and_Assessment</a> ► click on FAQs from the menu list on the left

Purchase Your Books
If you are attending the Cooper Campus, you may purchase your books at the Cooper Campus Barnes & Nobles branch (Oswald 120). For all other campus sites, purchase your books at the Leestown Campus (Building C, room 154). You may also purchase your books online by going to: <a href="www.kctcs.bncollege.com">www.kctcs.bncollege.com</a> and from the "select bookstore" box select *Bluegrass Cooper* (for Cooper & Regency books) or *Bluegrass Leestown* for that and all other Bluegrass campuses or *KCTCS Distance Learning* if taking online classes from any of the KCTCS colleges including Bluegrass. If you have been approved for financial aid, please check with that office in Oswald 12: on Cooper Campus or in the One Stop in Building C on Leestown Campus or call 855-246-2477 to find out if you can get permission to charge your books.
Check Your Contact Information for SNAP Alerts
Once you have registered for classes you are automatically enrolled in SNAP but check your contact information by logging on to the Student Self-Service Center at <a href="https://students.kctcs.edu">https://students.kctcs.edu</a> (click <i>login here</i> in gray) to make certain it is correct. SNAP is the <i>Safety Notification Alert Process</i> for the Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS). You will receive emergency notification messages such as cancellation or delay of classes your mobile phone or e-mail.
Purchase Your Parking Permit if Taking Classes on Cooper Campus with Plans to Park Your Car
For a <i>16-week Fall or Spring Semester</i> you can order online <u>www.uky.edu/Parking/permits-student-bctc</u> . You will need to provide your BCTC User ID and Password. Order at least two weeks prior to class start. You may also purchase these permits in person at UK Parking at any time.
If attending a <i>Fall II or Spring II 8-week session</i> or a <i>summer session</i> , you must buy your permits in person at the UK Parking Office, 721 Press Avenue.
