



Academic OneFile (InfoTrac)

	<p>3) Type your keywords in the box, separating them with AND <i>Ex. pregnancy AND smoking</i> (you can also type in phrases in quotation marks, such as “fetal alcohol syndrome”)</p>
	<p>4) You can limit to the following (click on Advanced Search):</p> <p>Full text</p> <p>Peer reviewed publications</p> <p>Published date</p> <p>Journal title</p>
