Transfer FAQs

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at Georgetown College?

When transferring to Georgetown, a student's GPA starts over and will not reflect prior grades. The prior grades, however, are assessed for the overall admissions decision.

Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?

Georgetown accepts a maximum of 66 credit hours for all incoming transfers.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree?

Georgetown College graduates typically must complete 120 total credit hours (with at least the last 30 coming from GC).

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?

Yes. Students are required to complete a foreign language through the 201 level (three semesters) although students may opt to test out of some or all of the required classes.

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships?

Yes. Transfers who are members of Phi Theta Kappa will receive \$5,000 per year. In addition, all transfers are eligible for the same scholarships as first-time freshmen, but these scholarships (with some exceptions) are awarded to those applying for the fall semester.

How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid?

Information about scholarships and financial aid as well as any additional applications can be found on Georgetown's website or by contacting the Office of Admissions.

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC? Will my academic bankruptcy be honored?

Repeat options and academic bankruptcy require approval from the Registrar's Office and are considered on a case-by-case basis.

How do I apply for admission?

A simple application can be found on our website or you can request a paper copy through the mail upon request to the Office of Admissions.

How can I contact an advisor in my major?

All faculty and staff contact information can be found on our website or by contacting the Office of Admissions.

What else should I know if I want to transfer to Georgetown College?

All prospective transfers must submit an application, high school transcript or proof of equivalency, and previous/current college transcripts. Depending on the criteria of the applicant, and ACT or SAT score may be requested.
