## **Transfer FAQs**

**Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at Kentucky State University?**

No.

**Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?**

Anyone applying with under 24 hours will be required to provide an ACT score and high school transcript.

**How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree?**

A minimum of 128 semester credit hours (excluding any college preparatory and remedial courses and any courses numbered below the 100 level) is required for the awarding of a baccalaureate degree. This includes a minimum of 45 semester credit hours in upper-level courses.

**Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?**

The University requires six hours but each student needs to consult their degree requirements for variances to these Liberal Studies requirements.

**Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships?**

Yes, we offer full-time student scholarships based on a GPA of 3.0 and above. The scholarships range from \$1,000 to \$2,000 and are renewable if the GPA is maintained.

**How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid?**

By filling out the FAFSA and going to our website under financial aid scholarships. The application is on line.

**Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC? Will my academic bankruptcy be honored?**

Yes.

**How do I apply for admission?**
