Sullivan University Transfer FAQs

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at Sullivan University?

Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred? Students must complete 25% of the classes in their degree program in residence here at Sullivan.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree? 180 for the majority of degrees (182 for Bachelor's in Paralegal Studies)

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree? No

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships? Contact Admissions Office for scholarship opportunities.

How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid? See your Financial Planning Coordinator to begin the process

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC? Will my academic bankruptcy be honored? Need definition of "repeat options..." We do not transfer in classes for which students have declared bankruptcy

How do I apply for admission? Contact the admissions office for application information.

How can I contact an advisor in my major? E-mail/Phone/Office Hours/Appt. – Students are not assigned to a particular advisor. They can see any advisor in their area of study. Office hours and contact info is posted quarterly.

What else should I know if I want to transfer to Sullivan University? Bring copies of your unofficial transcripts for a free transcript evaluation!
