Duplicated Enrollment - count of all emplids in all courses beginning with prefix NR, NRN, NSG, class section beginning with 16. If a student is enrolled in more than one class, they are counted multiple times

"With Cl" - Course format is lecture and clinical

Duplicated enrollment from class sections containing "L", "P," and C are excluded from all calculations.

With multiple instructors for a course, duplicate listings of students have been removed. Each student is used only once for specific course calculations and enrollment

Courses containing Clinical, Lab, and Lecture are designated as "Cl/La/Le"

Open Labs for students - 0 contact hours

The Danville/Lawrenceburg Nursing Program has 3 full-time faculty that each teach 18 student contact hours per week. All additional contact hours are taught by adjunct faculty
