WHAT IS THE QEP?

The Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) is part of the SACCS reaffirmation of accreditation. As a college, we need to develop and implement a plan that will be a student learning initiative and something that we can all rally around.



WHY DO WE NEED THE QEP?

The QEP gives us a chance to work across the college with a focus on student learning and the environment that supports it. The QEP needs to be rooted in institutional knowledge and data, and include broad based involvement. Its real goal is to engage in substantive and meaningful efforts that will make a significant difference in student success.



WHEN DOES OUR TOPIC NEED TO BE SELECTED?

We have a QEP Planning Committee with members from across the college. Our goal is to have the topic selected by January 2018.



WHAT IS THE PROCESS?

- 1) Getting the word out! Everyone needs to be aware that we are involved in the SACS reaffirmation process and that part of the process is choosing and implementing a QEP.
- 2) The QEP Planning team will conduct research and present a variety of options for consideration. Faculty, staff, and students will also have the opportunity to submit their ideas.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS?

3) Possible topics should be for programs/initiatives that will clearly enhance student learning and should be tied to our Mission and Strategic Plan. There should also be a need based on data that the college has collected in recent institutional assessments.

4) The possible topics will need to fit our inherent strengths and the institution's capacity.

*In other words, it needs to be meaningful and doable for our college. Cont.

- 5) Through input from all of our stakeholders, one topic will emerge.
- 6) The topic chosen will be recommended to LET (submitted to Dr. Julian and Dr. Feeney)
