

Faculty Compensation for On-Line Classes with Enrollment over the Class Cap (including merged sections)

Responsible Units: Academics, Vice President's Office

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If an instructor has merged sections of an on-line course (i.e., creating one section with a cap equivalent to the sum of the caps of the individual sections), the merged sections will count as only one section for workload/compensation until the original course cap is reached.

Full workload/compensation for an additional section will be based on the number of students enrolled at the end of the drop/add period beyond the college approved course cap and calculated at the rate of 1/12 of the regular workload/compensation for the course. Compensation per student may not exceed normal compensation for the class (e.g., for a three-credit hour course, the pay would be $1/12 \times \$725 \times 3 = \181.25 per student).

The number of students for which faculty will receive the compensation per student rate will be determined by the number of students enrolled at the end of the drop/add period. Note: If there are openings in another section of the same on-line course (regardless of instructor), students will be transferred to that section.
