

Faculty Compensation for On-Line Classes with Enrollment over the Class Cap

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If an instructor has merged sections of an on-line course (i.e., creating one section with a cap equivalent to the sum of the caps of the individual sections), the merged sections will count as only one section for workload/compensation until the original course cap is reached.

Full workload/compensation for an additional section will not be considered until student registration in the on-line merged course reaches 12 above the college approved course cap. If the merged course does not reach 12 above the approved course cap and all on-line sections of the same course are closed, then the instructor will be compensated for each student up to 11 over the class limit at the compensation per student amount of 1/12 of the regular compensation rate.

The number of students for which faculty will receive the compensation per student rate will be determined by the number of students enrolled at the end of the drop/add period. Note: If there are openings in another section of the same on-line course (regardless of instructor), students will be transferred to that section.
