#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Filmmaking Certificate Program at BCTC offers a unique opportunity to work with industry professionals in a master class setting. This is a one-semester, 16 credit hour, full-time program geared for emerging filmmakers at all levels of experience. #### HOW TO REGISTER

You must take FLM110, 120 and 130 in the same semester – a total of 12 credit hours. You can complete the certificate program and graduate in the same semester if you also complete TA126 and the Theatre Practicum. The Practicum will be offered during the semester and you will be notified how to register. There are NO pre-requisites.
