

General Occupational and Technical Studies

The program serves two general purposes that include an individualized program, providing a flexible curriculum that can be designed to meet specific student and workplace needs, and a degree completion program, providing a structure through which credit may be granted for significant prior learning experiences in occupational and technical areas. This model can combine certificates and/or diplomas in different disciplines for meeting employer needs for unique skill combinations for which there is no established degree program. As much as twenty hours of credit for experiential learning may be applied toward degree completion.
