The program prepares the individual to become a radiographer, which involves ionizing radiation for medical diagnostic imaging purposes. Instruction emphasizes radiation protection and quality patient care. Upon completion of the program, graduates are eligible to take the examination for registration as a radiographer by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists.
