The Automotive Technology program offers instruction in systems such as engines, fuel, on-board computers, transmissions, steering, suspension, and brakes to prepare students to qualify for an entry-level position in automotive repair.

Students can earn an Associate in Applied Science degree or diploma in Automotive Technology and specialized certificates are also available.

Automotive Technology at BCTC

The Automotive Technology program consists of lecture and laboratory classes with the possibility for cooperative education, practicum, or exploration of industry.

Classes are offered in person at the Leestown Campus.

Graduates of the program have excellent opportunities for employment with most employed in dealership service departments or independent automotive repair facilities.

Typical starting salaries for graduates range from \$13 to \$18 an hour depending on the student's level of competency. Salaries normally increase to \$35,000 to \$60,000 a year after two years of work experience with some students exceeding \$70,000.
