## Practical Nursing at BCTC

BCTC's Practical Nursing program combines classroom and online learning with hands-on skill labs and supervised clinical instruction in local health care and community facilities.

BCTC has two Practical Nursing programs, one at the Leestown Campus in Lexington and one at the Danville Campus. Classes take place during the day and clinical hours vary depending on the location.

The total cost for the PN program is about \$10,500. Scholarships and financial aid are available! If you are already working in healthcare, your employer may even provide tuition assistance.
