

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
between  
Eastern Kentucky University  
and  
Bluegrass Community and Technical College

For Matriculation of an Associate in Applied Science in  
Architectural Technology and a Bachelor of Science in Construction Management


Eastern Kentucky University (EKU) and Bluegrass Community and Technical College (BCTC), in order to contribute to the development of a seamless postsecondary education system for the citizens of Kentucky and to promote the transfer of credits between two institutions while increasing the educational opportunities for the students of the Central Kentucky area, hereby establish this Articulation and Transfer plan leading to an Associate in Applied Science in Architectural Technology from BCTC and a Bachelor of Science in Construction Management from EKU.

The following conditions apply to this Articulation and Transfer plan:

1. Upon successful completion of the attached programs leading to the Associate in Applied Science in Architectural Technology at BCTC and successful completion of the general education and support courses, BCTC graduates will be selected for admission to the Bachelor of Science program in Construction Management at EKU based on successfully meeting EKU's admission requirements and academic policies.
2. Successful completion of the Associate in Applied Science in Architectural Technology is defined by current standards of the program at BCTC.
3. Should requirements for graduation from the Associate in Applied Science in Architectural Technology program (BCTC) or from the Bachelor of Science in Construction Management program (EKU) change, these changes shall be communicated to the appropriate program and institution and shall result in the conditions of this agreement being reviewed.
4. BCTC associate degree students in Architectural Technology admitted to the bachelor degree program in Construction Management at EKU shall be awarded transfer credit and advanced credit as indicated in Attachment B and Attachment C.
5. BCTC and EKU agree to monitor and support the provisions of this Agreement to ensure consistency, program quality, and transferability for mutual benefit for the students.
6. BCTC and EKU will work together to design and place promotional materials, news releases, informative brochures, and paid advertising as a joint effort with the cost being shared by the two institutions.
7. BCTC and EKU will design a cooperative student advising system for ease of student transfer.
8. When in their best interest, students will be able to concurrently enroll at both BCTC and EKU to complete courses required for both degrees.
9. Both institutions will observe Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) and Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE) policies, standards, and procedures and will adhere to the requirements of reporting information to these and other agencies.
10. This agreement can be terminated with written notification at least sixty (60) days prior to termination. Arrangements will be made to allow students already enrolled under the terms of this Agreement to complete the program in a timely manner.

11. This Agreement will be reviewed for possible updates and renewal at least every three (3) years.

This Agreement becomes effective upon the signatures of all parties.

**2014 Update to Architectural Technology – Construction Management**

**CONDITIONS:**

1. KCTCS 2013-2014 Catalog and ECU 2014-2015 Catalog are applicable.
2. Student Transfer Planning Guide shows transfer courses and when they normally occur
3. Waive BTO 100(1) due to transfer of more than 60 credit hours.
4. Architectural Technology technical elective courses, taken at KCTCS, that differ from the recommended elective courses will result in a correspondingly heavier course load at ECU.
5. If BCTC student is not able to take the minimum one hour of Cooperative Education (COE 199), the student shall be required to take another Architectural Technology technical elective to meet the current 10 hour requirement and another hour of Cooperative Education at ECU.
6. Student shall consult with an Architectural Technology advisor to determine which BCTC courses will satisfy both the BCTC Heritage/Humanities requirement and the ECU GE 3B Humanities requirement.
