LPN candidates are admitted in the spring semester into the NSG 197 course. Selective admission process for LPNs.

- A letter grade of "C" or higher is required for each nursing course, each biological courses, and math course.
- Non nursing courses must be taken prior to or concurrent with the semester sequence in which the student is enrolling in nursing
- Successful completion of each nursing course in each semester is required before one may progress to the next semester of the program.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 must be met in order to apply and then maintained after admission to the nursing program.
