Bluegrass Community & Technical College Opportunity College Information 2014-2015

Opportunity College is collaboration between area high schools and Bluegrass Community & Technical College (BCTC). It provides juniors and seniors with the opportunity to earn college credit while still in high school.

Juniors and seniors may be dually enrolled in both high school and BCTC at the same time.

- **Dual Credit** provides both high school and college credit
- **Dual Enrollment** provides college credit only

Courses are offered at all BCTC campuses and at some High School and Area Technology Center sites.

- HS student pay \$50 Administrative fee for courses taken at most high school sites; BCTC waives tuition (*Some high school sites may charge 50% tuition)
- HS student pay **regular BCTC tuition & fees** for courses taken at any BCTC campus
- Additional costs include textbooks, fees, and transportation costs

To enroll, all students must meet minimum ACT, SAT or COMPASS score requirements, as well as course prerequisites.

Courses on campus follow the BCTC Academic Calendar and may require students to attend class on days when their high school is not in session. Courses at the high school site follow the high school calendar.

To apply for **Opportunity College** courses, submit the following to either your HS Guidance Counselor or teacher (if enrolling at the HS site) or the BCTC Opportunity College Office (if enrolling on a BCTC campus):

- College application (http://www.bluegrass.kctcs.edu/en/Admissions/How_to_Apply.aspx)
- Official high school transcript
- Official ACT, SAT or COMPASS scores
- Dual credit enrollment form OR meet with Opportunity College advisor
- Letter of recommendation from high school teacher or counselor
- FERPA/parent permission form
