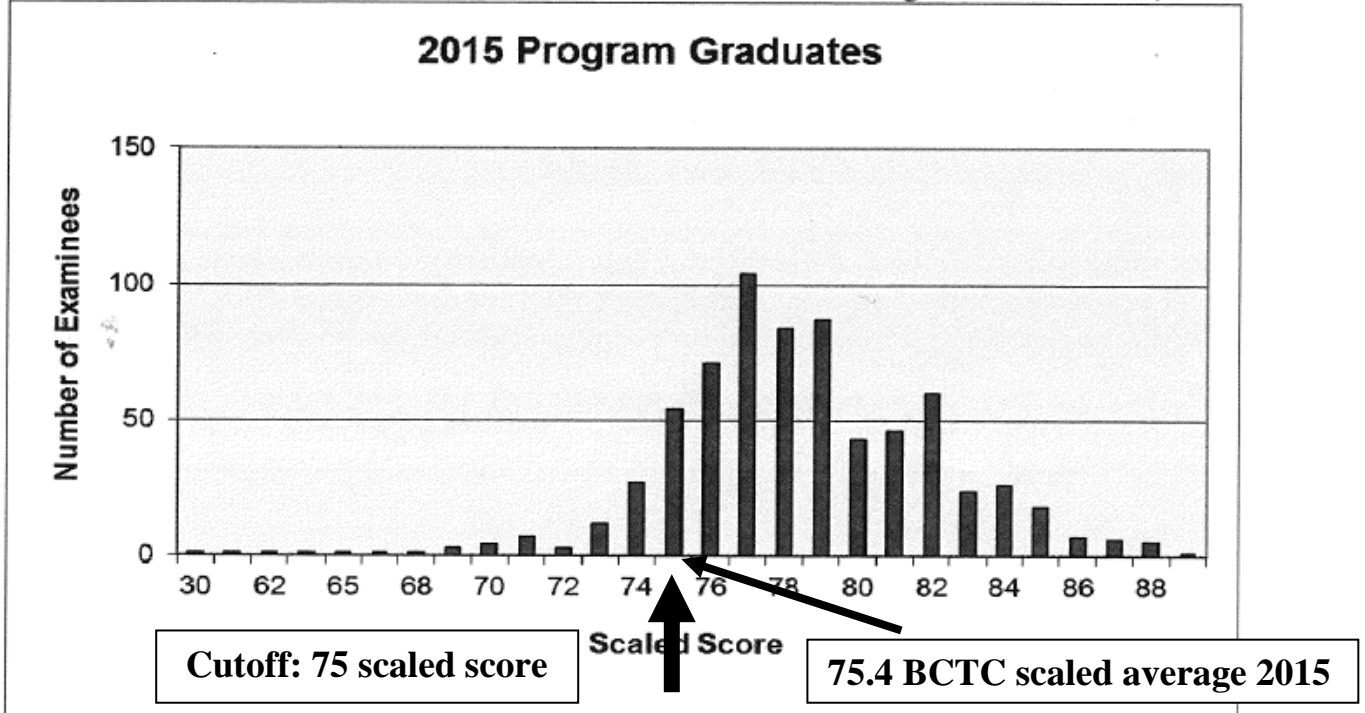

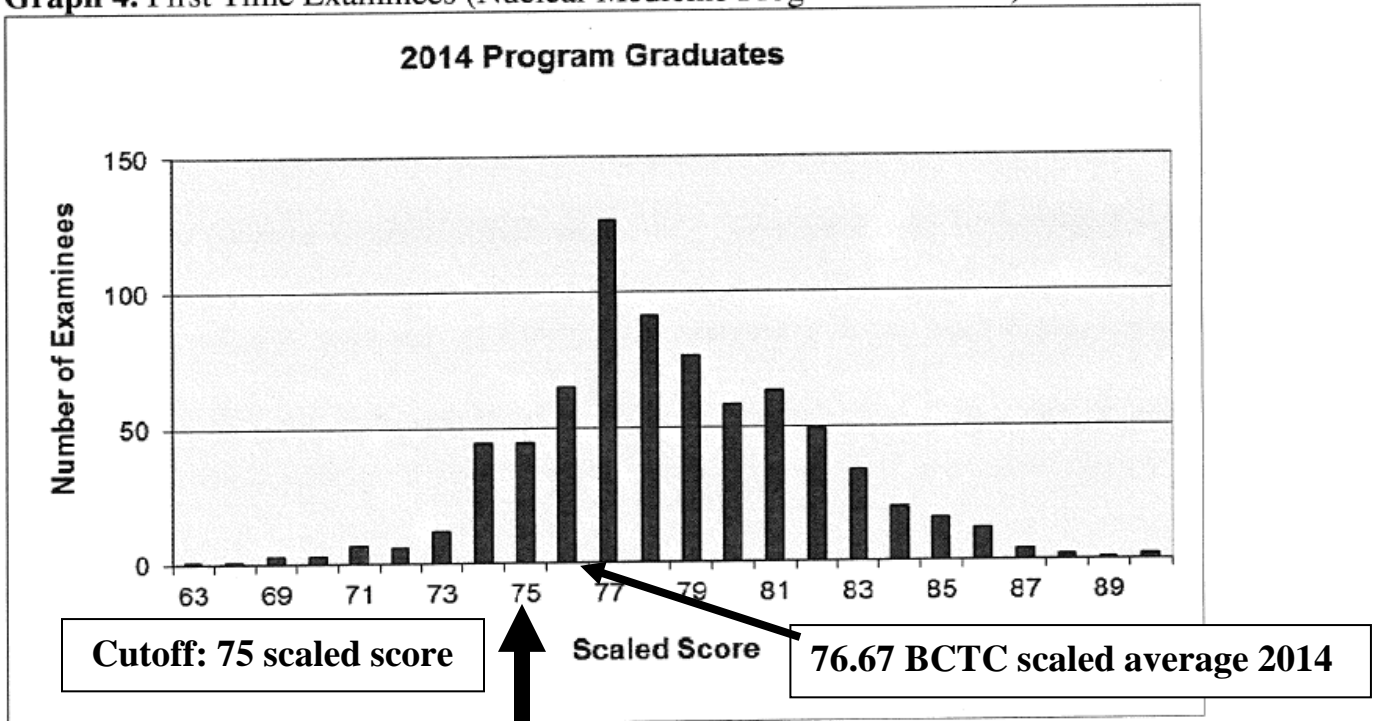

Graph 4. First Time Examinees (Nuclear Medicine Program Graduates)



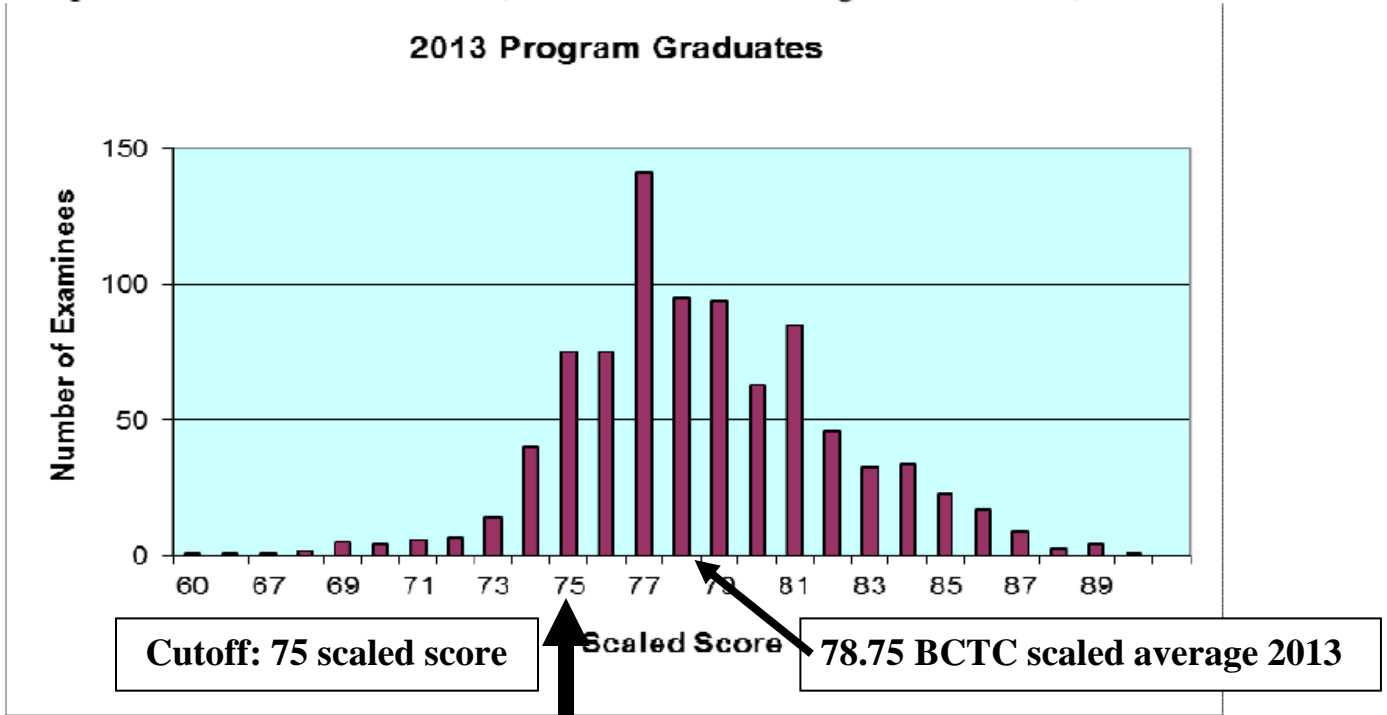

Graph 4. First Time Examinees (Nuclear Medicine Program Graduates)



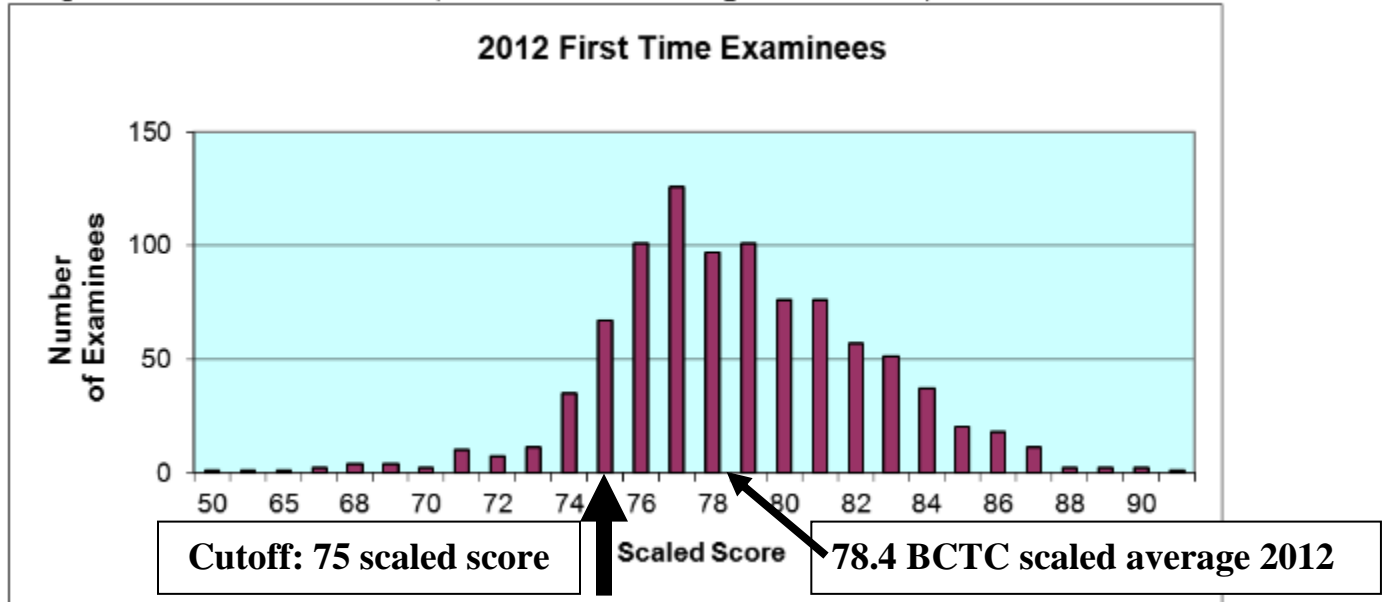

Graph 4. First Time Examinees (Nuclear Medicine Program Graduates)



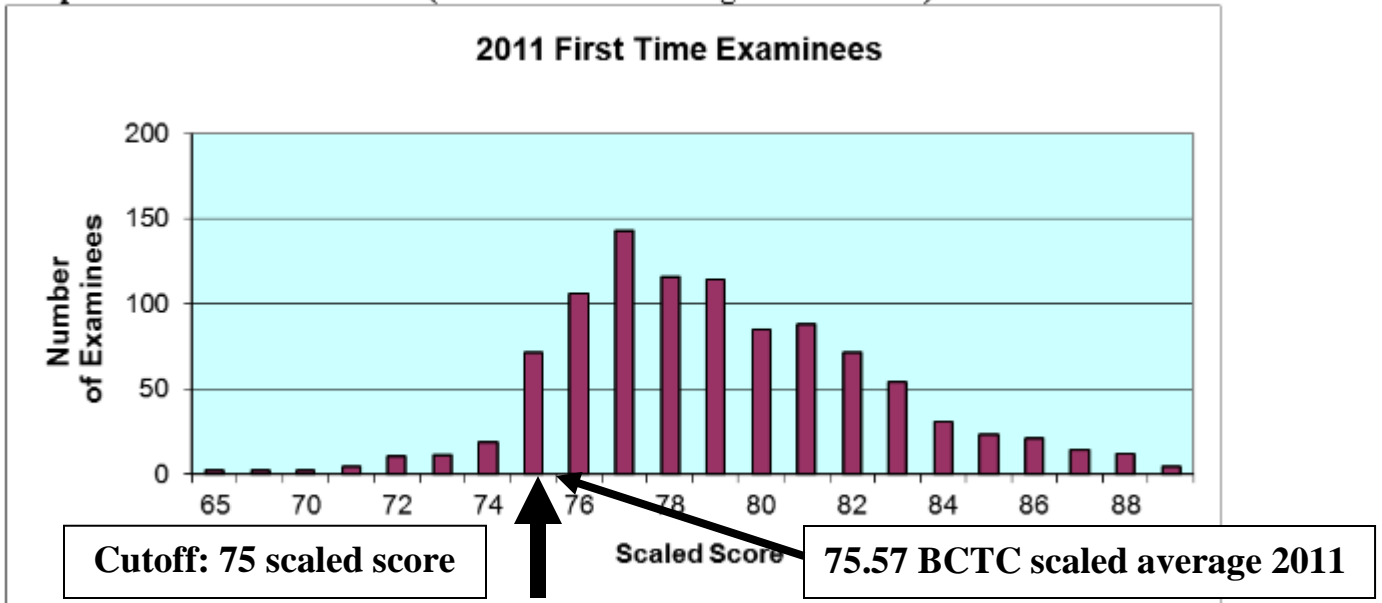
