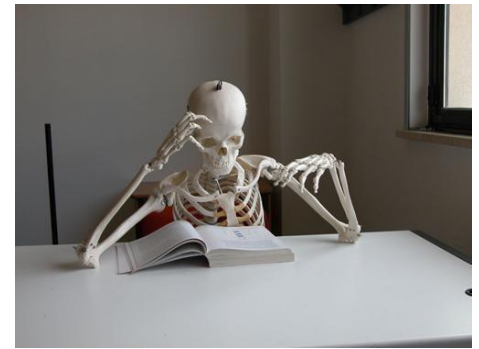

 - Documentation of digital literacy as defined by KCTCS prior to admission to IMG courses.
 - Completion of the following and submitted documentation:

 - Background Check**
 - Drug Screening**
 - CPR**

- Any student missing orientation will be dismissed from the program. The orientation covers vital information pertaining to the program requirements.

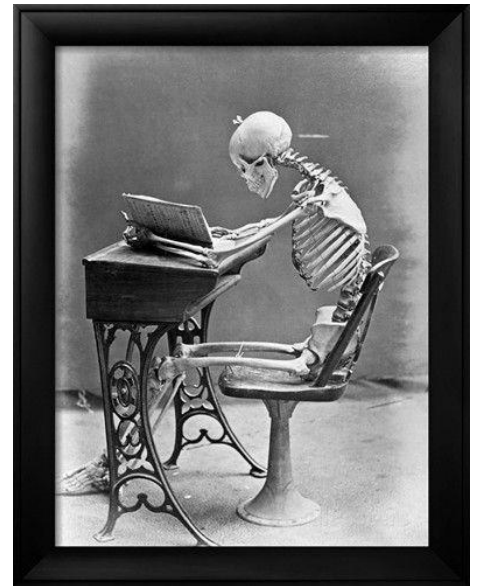
More Important News – Things to be Thinking About..

- **Insurance** – All students must have proof of medical insurance before the start of the program. This insurance must be current throughout the program.
 - **Malpractice Insurance** – Malpractice insurance fees will be included with your tuition and can be estimated at around \$20.00 a year.
- **Uniform purchase** – All students must purchase a radiography uniform before the start of clinical. Additional information will be posted before the start of the fall semester. Additional information concerning requirements for shoes, hair, body art, etc. will be posted and discussed before the start of the semester.
- **Markers (Radiographic)** – All students will need to bring a personal check/money order for \$40.00 payable to Commonwealth X-ray on August 11, 2016 for two sets of lead markers. All students must have radiographic markers to attend the clinical portion of the program. There is no refund for markers purchased if student withdraws from the program.
- **Books** – The bookstore is located on Cooper Campus and will provide all the necessary books utilized within the program. A list of books will be posted within the website under “Incoming Students”.
 - **BCTC Handbook & Clinical Log book.** Your BCTC handbook must be purchased and brought to orientation.
