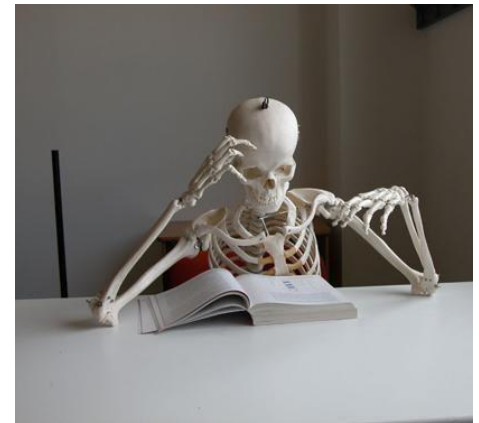

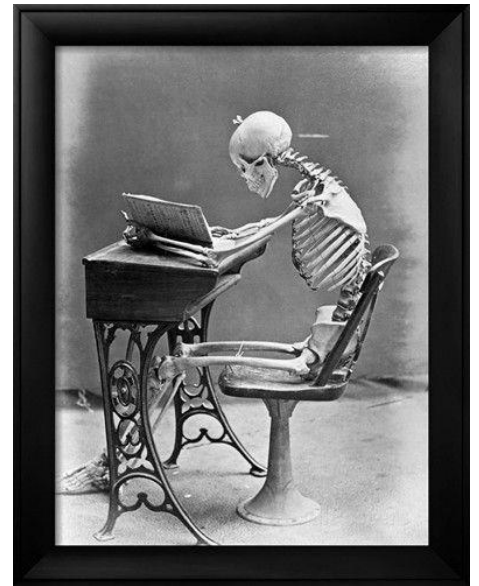
- Students that miss orientation “will be dismissed” from the program. The orientation covers vital information pertaining to the program requirements.

## More Important News – Things to be Thinking About..

- **Insurance** – All students must have proof of medical insurance before the start of the program. This insurance must be current throughout the program.
- **Uniform purchase** – All students must purchase a radiography uniform before the start of clinical. Additional information will be posted before the start of the fall semester. All uniforms will be purchase at a vendor designated by the program. Additional information concerning requirements for shoes, hair, body art, etc. will be posted and discussed before the start of the semester.
- **Markers (Radiographic)** – All students will need to purchase radiographic markers before the start of the program. The estimated cost for markers are \$45.00 - \$70.00 which includes two sets. All students must have radiographic markers to attend the clinical portion of the program. There is no refund for markers purchased if student withdraws from the program. Additional information will be sent later.
- **Books** – The bookstore is located on Cooper Campus and will provide all the necessary books utilized within the program. A list of books will be posted within the website under “Incoming Students”. The cost of books will be discussed later.
  - **BCTC Handbook & Clinical Log book.** To be discussed at orientation.
