New Horizons Conference: Call for Musical Performers

[The Bluegrass Community and Technical College](#) in conjunction with the [KCTCS Office of Professional Development](#) is excited to be hosting the first annual KCTCS Musical Performance Event in conjunction with the fifth annual KCTCS Art Exhibit at the upcoming [New Horizons Conference](#) in May. We are looking for talented performers among faculty and staff throughout the KCTCS system to highlight our Art Exhibit with performances of their vocal and or acoustical musical talents. Participants submitting examples of their work (MP3 format preferred) or CD prior to March 25th, will have their names, if accepted, listed in the New Horizons Conference Program. Notification of acceptance will be sent within two weeks of submission. If you are not attending the entire conference, we will try to develop a schedule that will allow for your performance if possible.

This is a juried performance event. In the case of large number of entries, the review committee may have to limit the length of individual performance schedules or the number of accepted applications. We will try to work with accepted performers conference attendance schedules to assign performance times where possible. Performances are limited to **non-amplified, acoustical and vocal performances** due to the venue and other conference site considerations.

Late submissions must be received no later than **May 1st** for jurors to review. Late submissions will be notified if they have been accepted no later than May 9th. Note: Late deadline submissions will not be listed in the conference program. We strongly encourage you to submit your entry prior to the program deadline of **March 25th**.

All performances will be in conjunction with or adjacent to the KCTCS Art Exhibit. Performers are responsible for providing their own instruments as well as the security of their instruments before and after their performance. Please note that we cannot allow performers to solicit sales of music CD's etc. at their performance or at the Conference.
