

BCTC Ebrary to Ebook Central Transition: Q & A

Ebrary is now Ebook Central. See below for some answers to your questions about the transition.

Does Ebook Central have the same content / books as ebrary?

Yes; you still will have access to over 120,000 high quality academic books.

Do I search for books in the same way?

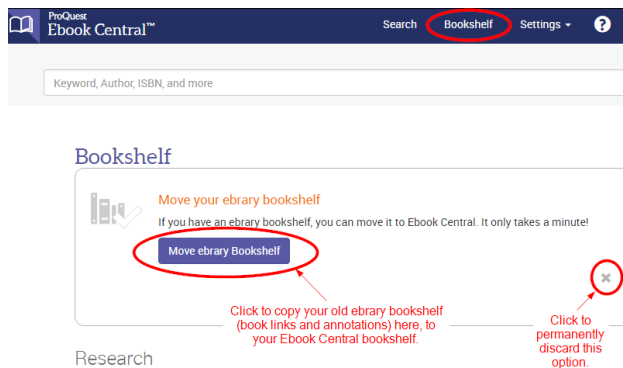
Yes; most of the basic functions, such as searching /opening /downloading books, operate in the same way as in ebrary.

I tried to log into my personal ebrary account on Ebook Central, using my ebrary credentials, but it won't let me log in. What do I do?

Most personal ebrary accounts have transferred over, but there may be a few that did not, especially if older accounts. If you cannot log into your previously created ebrary personal account, please contact ebooksupport@proquest.com

I was able to log into my personal account, using my old ebrary credentials, but I don't see my old ebrary saved book shelf in Ebook Central. What do I do?

After logging in to your personal account, click on the bookshelf link at the top of the Ebook Central page. Then, click on the blue box to "move ebrary bookshelf." (If you would rather discard your old ebrary book shelf, click the discard x, instead)
