



Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred? Brescia University accepts up to 67 credit hours from community colleges. If a student graduates from a KCTCS School with an Associate of Arts or Science, they qualify for the block transfer agreement. This agreement guarantee's 60 hours of transfer credit and junior standing at Brescia University.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree? Bachelor's degrees require 128 credit hours. The number of credits you will need depends on how many transfer credits are awarded.

Is there a foreign language requirement? Yes, one three-credit hour foreign language course is required. Sign language is not accepted for the language requirement at this time.

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships? No, the BUonline tuition is already deeply discounted from the tuition rate of our traditional students, so scholarships are not available.

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC schools? Yes.

Brescia U Block Transfer Agreement

This block transfer agreement recognizes a minimum of sixty transfer credits and awards junior standing to any graduate from a KCTCS institution, with an associate of arts or an associate of science degree.

An Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree will also satisfy forty-eight hours of Brescia University's General Education Requirements (GERs) provided the student completes at least one class in world history, foreign language, literature, fine arts, philosophy, and religion. Courses not completed at a KCTCS institution will have to be completed at Brescia University as part of the student's free elective coursework. Also, at least six credit hours of a student's free elective courses will have to be completed at the 300 or 400 level.
