Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?

There is no limit to the number of credit hours that can be transferred.

However, students should be aware that there are limits to the number of credit hours a student may earn in any one term. The amount of credit hours transferred *per semester* must not exceed the maximum number of semester hours that students are allowed to take at EKU.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree?

A minimum of 30 semester hours must be taken at EKU if the student is pursuing a baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 15 hours must be taken at EKU to earn an associate degree.

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships?

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC?

EKU honors the quality points and credits earned on transfer transcripts. If a course is no longer counted in the GPA because of a repeat policy at the transfer institution, then the course will be reflected in the same way at EKU. EKU also honors the bankrupted work from other institutions

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at EKU?

Yes.
