Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?

Students can transfer up to 30 hours towards an Associate degree and 80 hours towards a Bachelor degree. Credits from any regionally accredited institution will transfer. Midway also offers credit through experiential learning. College credit may be awarded through the use of computerized CLEP/DANTES tests or through portfolio documentation. Military credits are also transferrable.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a Bachelor's degree?

Associate degree students must earn 27 of the last 30 credit hours, and Bachelor degree students must earn 36 of their last 40 credit hours at Midway in order to fulfill the graduation requirement.

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?

No. There is NO foreign language requirement for any of our bachelor degrees.

Does your institution offer KCTCS or BCTC transfer scholarships?

Transfer scholarships are available for the Women's Day College. For the evening and online program students who receive their Associates in Science, Arts, or Applied Science with a 3.0 or higher may receive 1,000.00 scholarship valid for two years.

How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid?

Women's Day College students are automatically considered for scholarships upon the completion of the application. All students seeking financial aid must complete the FAFSA. Midway's FAFSA code is **001975**. For specific questions, please contact the Financial Aid office at (859) 846-5410.
