Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?

No

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor's degree?

A minimum of 40 hours must be earned in residence at Murray State. A candidate for the Bachelor of Integrated Studies degree will require only 32 hours to be earned in residence at Murray State.

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor's degree?

Yes, for the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Arts in Business and for the Bachelor of Music—Performance option degrees.

How do I apply for admission?

1. Complete an Application for Admission (murraystate.edu/apply)
2. Submit a non-refundable \$40 application fee
3. Submit "official" transcripts from each college attended
4. Submit "official" high school transcript and "official" ACT scores if a student has less than 24 college credit hours.

How do I apply for financial aid and other scholarships?

To apply for scholarships, visit murraystate.edu/scholarships by June 1st of every year. To apply for financial aid, complete the FAFSA at fafsa.ed.gov and contact the Financial Aid Office at 270-809-2546 if you have further questions.

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC?

We will apply Murray State repeat policies to all transfer work.

Will my academic bankruptcy be honored?

No.

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at Murray?

Yes.

How can I contact an advisor in my major?

Once a student is admitted, they will receive an evaluation of their transcript plus contact information about their academic advisor.
