Are there a limited number of credit hours that can be transferred?

No, a student can transfer an unlimited number of hours to NKU.

How many credit hours must I complete at your institution to earn a bachelor’s degree? A student must complete their last 30 hours at NKU to be considered for a degree. However, majors such as nursing, education, and most business majors graduate with more than 120 hours.

Is there a foreign language requirement to receive a bachelor’s degree? There is no universal requirement for all students to take foreign language. However, some majors including Biology and Art History do require foreign language. These kinds of major specific requirements change year to year and is best for the student to contact NKU to make sure that his/her chosen major does or does not have a foreign language requirement.

How do I apply for other scholarships and financial aid?

Will your institution honor all of my repeat options from BCTC? If a student has taken all of his/her classes at BCTC and has applied repeat options, NKU will accept them. If a student fails a class at NKU and repeats the class at BCTC, different rules *may* apply. I highly encourage a student to contact NKU prior to repeating a class at BCTC that he/she has failed at NKU.

Will my GPA from BCTC be averaged with my new GPA at NKU? Students who first registered for any course at NKU in **Fall 2009 and forward** will **not** have the grades associated with transfer coursework included in their GPA calculation at NKU, though the credit hours are generally accepted and specific course equivalencies are assigned for all courses with passing grades of D- or better. In other words, transfer students with no prior NKU coursework as of today will begin at NKU with a brand new GPA

How can I contact an advisor in my major?

A student cannot contact an advisor until he/she is fully admitted to NKU. Once admitted, a packet of information is sent that alerts the student as to how to contact the advisor.
