# Mandatory Placement

- **Key Features of 2017-2018 MP Policy**
  - College Readiness Indicators Updated (CPE)
  - Test scores valid for 3-years
  - **WONDERLIC Basic Skills Test is the NEW default placement test for incoming freshman.**
  - College Math Pathways Added
  - **Developmental English and Reading Pathways NEW**
  - Placement charts updated to include accelerated and co-requisite options
  - **Important to Review MP Policy EACH semester**

# Reading and English Advising

- **Advising Holds**

- ***DO NOT*** lift Self-Service Enrollment Holds for students in **IRW85**. Students must meet advisors to Add/Drop a Class.

- **Limited Class List Available for RDG and IRW**

- Students enrolled in a transitional reading (RDG) class or Transitional Integrated Reading and Writing (IRW) class may only register for courses from the ***IRW-RDG Allowed Courses List***.

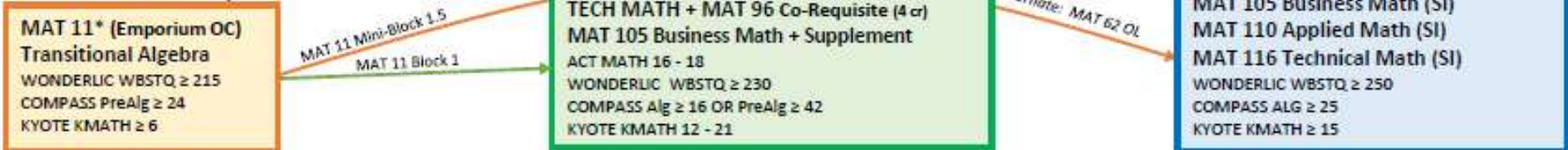

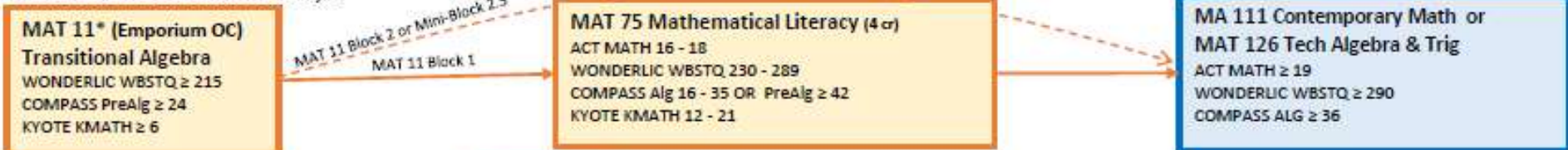

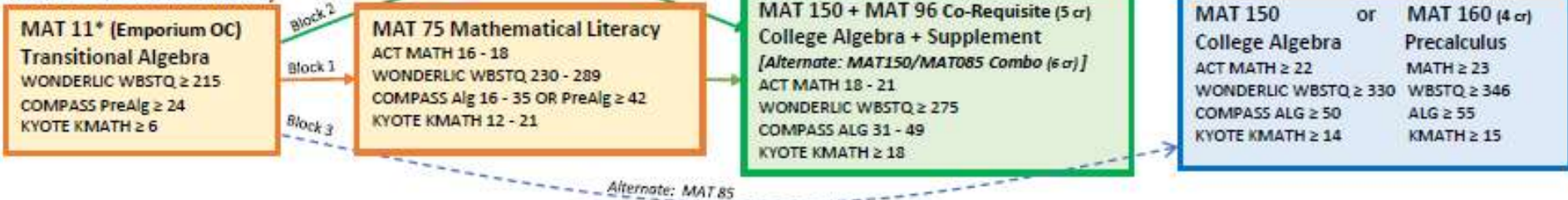
### Technical Math Pathway

### \* MAT 11 includes multiple entry/exit paths

Making Progress (MP)  $\rightarrow$  Re-enroll in MAT 11

Pass (P)  $\rightarrow$  Block Complete + STEP Credit OR KYOTE Placement

Block 1 (Modules 1 - 4) = MAT 55      Mini-Block 1.5 = MAT 62

Block 2 (Modules 5 - 8) = MAT 75      Mini-Block 2.5 = MAT 75

Block 3 (Modules 9 - 12) = MAT 85

### Prior Course Work Prerequisite Paths:

RDG 20  $\rightarrow$  RDG 100 Co-Requisite or RDG 185

ENC 90  $\rightarrow$  ENG 101 + ENG 100 or ENC 91

MAT 55  $\rightarrow$  MAT 11, MAT 62, MAT 75, or TECH MATH + MAT 96

MAT 65  $\rightarrow$  MAT 11, MAT 75, MAT 85, TECH MATH, MAT 126, or MAT150 + MAT 96

MAT 85  $\rightarrow$  MA 111, MAT 150, or MAT160





# Math Advising

- **Math Course Enrollment Request Form**

- Use the online *Math Course Enrollment Request Form* for the following:
  - **Leaving MAT011:** All current, and sometimes former, MAT011 students entering a non-MAT011 math class. [Note: Entering MAT011 does not require enrollment form.]
  - **Entering a UK Courses:** MA111, MA113, MA114, MA162, MA201, STA296
  - **Co-Requisites and Combo Courses:** All “A” section courses and “M” section courses [Make sure to enroll student in corresponding section numbers.]

- **Special Reminders:**

- MA113 requires prior Trigonometry course prerequisite
- STA296 requires prior Calculus course prerequisite



# MAT011 Transitional Algebra

- **Emporium – (Only Available On-Campus)**

- **Computerized Lectures/Assignments, Flexible Pacing, Mastery Learning, Individualized Assignments & Pathways, KYOTE Testing, Acceleration & Roll-Over Options.**

- To utilize Roll-Over option, must earn MP or P and be continuously enrolled in MAT011 each semester, including at least 1 summer term *until* STEP credit earned.
- Summer 1 → 8-week MTR, also available hybrid and evening sections
- Summer 2 → 6-week term, MTWR

- **ALL Pathways: Tech, Liberal Arts, College Algebra, Calculus**

- **Advisor Notes for MAT011**

- **Priority Registration:**

- Progress reports provided to students around week 12.
- Re-enroll in MAT011 unless progress report from instructor states otherwise.

- **Online Math Course Enrollment Request Form:**

- Indicate MAT011 Block Completion and State Section in Comments
