

## Advising Notes for Current Emporium Students for Summer/Fall 2014 terms

**ALL emporium courses will be replaced with MAT011 Transitional Algebra beginning Summer 2014.**

### About MAT011 (Emporium):

- MAT011 includes all the content for MAT055, MAT065, MAT075 and MAT085, thus MAT011 can replace any or all of the standard developmental courses.
- Students will start in MAT011 at the same level they would start normally with an emporium course.
  - Students who finish their current course would start with the next level course within MAT011.
  - Students who do not finish their current course and enroll in MAT011 for the Summer term, would meet the “continuous enrollment in emporium” requirement and start at the last Unit completed.
  - Students who do not finish their current course and don’t enroll until the Fall term would start at the beginning of their current level course and “test-out” of concepts previously learned.
- A student will only have to complete the content in MAT011 he/she needs to meet the prerequisites for the specific entry college level math course for his/her degree.
- A student’s program plan (major) determines which college level math course is needed.
- Some students may need more than one semester in MAT011 to complete all of their prerequisites.
- **MAT011 will NOT require lab hours during the Summer term.**

*Example:* Technical Math Courses only need MAT065, MA111 only needs MAT075, and MAT150 needs through MAT085. Prerequisites for all of these paths can be met by completing the corresponding content in MAT011.

### For students currently enrolled in an Emporium math class:

#### 1. If you ARE at least halfway through your current Emporium course and are likely to finish and

##### a) **WOULD like to continue with Emporium for the next course:**

Enroll in MAT011 for the Summer and/or Fall term. You will be able to start at the next course level and move forward through the developmental sequence at your pace.

##### b) **DO NOT want to continue with Emporium for the next course:**

Enroll in the next course for either Summer or Fall term. It will be a standard lecture course.

*Note: If you do not finish the Emporium course this semester, you will be “kicked-out” of a standard lecture course for not meeting the prerequisites and required to retake COMPASS placement or re-enroll in your current course or MAT011.*

#### 2. If you are NOT at least halfway through your current Emporium course and

##### a) **WOULD like to continue with Emporium for the current course:**

Enroll in MAT011 for the Summer and/or Fall term

*Note: To meet the “continuous enrollment” condition where you start at the point you end this semester, you must enroll in the Summer term.*

##### b) **DO NOT want to continue with Emporium for the current course:**

Re-enroll in the current course (MAT055, MAT065, MAT075, MAT085) for either Summer or Fall term.

*Note: You will be starting the course from the beginning and it will be a standard lecture course.*
