**ADMISSION STANDARDS: For Students entering NSG 210 or NSG 197 or NSG 212:**

By the first day of classes, you must have the following courses, or the approved equivalent courses, completed in order to maintain your admission status:

- MAT 150 or MA 111 or higher,
- PSY 110,
- PSY 223,
- BIO 137 & BIO 139
- computer literacy requirement
- a CNA course or equivalency (recent PN graduate, LPN, or previously enrolled in the nursing program in the past year)

\*In addition, Mathematics, and BIO must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. BIO 139 must have been taken within the past six years.

**ADMISSION STANDARDS: For Students entering NSG 230:**

By the first day of classes, you must have the following courses, or the approved equivalent courses, completed in order to maintain your admission status:

- MAT 150 or MA 111 or higher
- PSY 110
- PSY 223
- BIO 137 & BIO 139
- BIO 225
- computer literacy requirement
- a CNA course or equivalency (recent PN graduate, LPN, or previously enrolled in the nursing program in the past year)
- ENG 101 & 102
- COM course

Mathematics, and BIO must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. BIO 139 & BIO 225 must have been taken within the past six years.

**STATEMENT OF INTENT:** You must accept your spot in the SAS account within 2 weeks of notification of your acceptance email. **We will withdraw your acceptance and offer your position in the Nursing class to the next qualified alternate if we you do not accept your spot in your SAS account.**

**VERY IMPORTANT:** If at any point you do not plan to enroll in the Nursing Program, please notify the Bluegrass Office of Admissions, at 859.246.6212, as soon as possible so that another student can be contacted. It is vital that we are able to fill all positions in the class and, just as you, other students are very anxious to begin making their plans

**IMMUNIZATIONS:** All students must set up a Castlebranch account so a background check and immunizations can be processed and reviewed. Please refer to the document posted on the BCTC ADN webpage regarding immunizations for all important details that must be completed by **January 8, 2017.**

For students that already have a Castlebranch account, you still must update your background check, drug screen, and immunizations via this system.

- Cooper students that have been previously enrolled in the ADN nursing program at BCTC, use the BL64re code in Castlebranch system
- Cooper students that are new to the BCTC ADN nursing program, must use the BL64 code
- Lawrenceburg students that have been previously enrolled the nursing program at BCTC ADN program, use the BL60re code in Castlebranch system
- Lawrenceburg students that are new to the BCTC ADN nursing program, must use the BL60 code in the Castlebranch system.

**PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE:** All students must purchase professional liability insurance. This is included in your tuition and fees and must be paid each semester.
