### Additional Information

- A letter grade of "C" or higher is required for each nursing course, each biological/physical science course, and any qualifying math course.
- Non-NSG course(s) must be taken prior to or concurrent with the semester sequence in which the student is enrolling in nursing.
- Successful completion of each nursing course in each semester is required before one may progress to the next semester of the program.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 must be met in order to apply and then maintained after admission to the nursing program.
- Failure to complete the delineated sequencing of the courses and curriculum will result in withdrawal from the program.
- The Associates Degree Nursing Program is a total of 71 credit hours excluding Pre-Requisites listed above.

# Selective Admission: Associate Degree Nursing (RN)

The process for applying is a “Complete Application Packet” format. Students must submit all documents by the date specified on the BCTC web site in order to be considered for admission. Only complete packets will be processed and considered for the program.

1. Create a Selective Admissions System (SAS) account at <http://tinyurl.com/bctclrnselect>
  2. The process for applying is a “Complete Application Packet format.” Students must submit all documents below in one envelope to be considered for the program. Even if you have applied before and/or are currently enrolled, we will need all documents resubmitted to one of these locations:
    - The Office of Admissions, Cooper Campus, Rm.119 Oswald Building
    - The Lawrenceburg Campus
- Once you have an active SAS account print a **program checklist** to begin the process. You must submit the checklist with your packet. Gather all of the documents required from the checklist for consideration to the Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program and place them in one envelope.
  - Official high school transcript (**for current high school students only**).
  - Official scores of the *NLN PAX-RN* exam. Must be current within 3 years.
  - Official transcripts of all post-secondary education attempted. Transcripts must be submitted from EACH college or university previously attended and must show every period of enrollment. Transcripts from the *Kentucky Community and Technical College System* do **not** need to be submitted.
  - In order to be considered for admission to the Associate Degree Nursing (RN) Program, each applicant must attend a mandatory pre-admission conference with the Program Coordinator.
