### Additional Information

- BIO 135 is recommended for Pharmacy Technician students. BIO 137 and BIO 139 are recommended for Pre-Pharmacy or other healthcare programs.
- A letter grade of C or higher in each course is required to continue in the program.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 must be maintained after admission to the Pharmacy Technician program.
