Information on Crisis Management Teams

Crisis Management Teams (CMT) serve various functions at all BCTC campus sites and consists of seven full-time Safety and Security Officers along with part-time officers. These officers have been trained in the Incident Command System (**ICS**) and the National Incident Management System (**NIMS**). Each campus has a full-time officer assigned who coordinates activities with their respective campus CMT members. Officers have regular meetings at their campus sites, with a district-wide meeting conducted at least each academic year.

CMT members are tasked to respond to a variety of events based on standard emergency management principles for “all-hazards” incidents. Training emphasis is placed on those events that, through risk assessments, have a higher likelihood of occurrence at BCTC sites. These events can include evacuations, severe weather sheltering, violent incidents on campus, disruptive persons, medical incidents, and emergency communications.

Each campus site is unique and has specific needs and are taken into consideration as preparedness efforts, training curriculums and protocols, are developed and refined. Operational procedures and strategies are constantly assessed, reviewed, and revised as needed through After-Action Reports (AAR) and post-incident briefings.

Incidents at BCTC are managed utilizing the Incident Command Systems (ICS) and the Unified Command System when involving outside agencies. More information regarding the BCTC Crisis Management Teams is available by contacting the campus Security Officer.
